

Covid-19 update

Staff do their twice weekly **lateral flow Covid tests** at home. So far **all results have been negative**. It's not a particularly nice experience but it is what we all have to do to ensure all staff are well and able to do their job.

We have had **no positive test results for children** in school and we have not had to close any groups due to a positive test result for our staff and children or via close contacts.

The testing process may well provide us with some asymptomatic positive test results. If this is the case, it will impact on what we can offer in terms of face to face teaching in school.

Given the prevalence of the virus in England, it is highly likely that we will have to **send home a whole class group**, rather than small groups of children, in the event of a **positive test result**.

It is therefore worth having a **Plan B** for child care available to you, just in case we need to send your child home to isolate for a number of days or if we have to close your child's group. Hopefully this won't happen but it's always good to have a backup plan, particularly as any changes we are required to make are likely to be at short notice.

Returning to school

As I am sure you are now aware, school will reopen to all pupils in all year groups from **Monday 08 March**. We have sent out a separate letter to parents of children in each class to explain the routines and controls that we have put in place to make school as safe a place as possible for your child.

We are one of a very small number of schools with **no positive test results for children** in school and we have not had to close any groups due to a positive test result for our staff and children or via close contacts. Our aim is to keep it this way.

Please read the letter we have sent out carefully and contact us next week if there is anything you are worried about. We are working hard as a staff team to review our planned curriculum and have everything in place ready to welcome all children back to school where they belong.

In the meantime, **remote learning** will continue to be provided via Tapestry for children in Orange and Yellow class and via Google Classroom for children in Red, Green and Blue class. It is really important that children engage with the remote learning provided by their teachers until school reopens to all pupils.

PE days for spring term B

Children in all year groups should **come to school wearing PE kit on their PE days**. We are not changing into PE kit in school. They should wear their school jumper/cardigan and polo top as normal with plain black or dark joggers or leggings and trainers. They can wear shorts underneath if they wish.
