Sports days on Tuesday and Thursday

Information for spectators

- **Dogs** are not allowed on the school premises, including those being carried in coats and bags.
- **Smoking**, including vaping, is not permitted on the school premises.
- Parents and carers are welcome to stay and wait for the event to start when they drop off children from 8:35am. Sports will start at approximately 9:15am.
- Drinks will be on sale throughout each morning.

In the event of bad weather

If the weather is bad or if the grass is too wet and therefore dangerous, sports days will be cancelled and we will try again on the reserve dates. If you are in any doubt, please check the school website, where a message will be displayed by 8:00am.

PE kit

Parents are responsible for providing their child with a school PE kit. Children need their **school PE kit** (white t-shirt and dark shorts) and **trainers** for all PE lessons. PE lessons are likely to take place **outdoors** in the summer term depending on the weather. Children need their trainers for every lesson. **School shoes cannot be worn for PE lessons.**

Our expectations of a white shirt, dark shorts and trainers are very reasonable, especially compared to some schools where children must have a wide range of much more expensive items including things with school embroidered logos etc.

PE is a statutory part of the national curriculum and is not optional. Please support us to make a prompt start to PE lessons by ensuring your child has their top, shorts and trainers at school on PE days. Valuable time is wasted at the start of every PE lesson trying to sort out spare kit which reduces teaching time.

Bus passes for children in Blue class

Year 4 children who live in Seghill are entitled to a place on a school transport bus when they transfer to Seaton Sluice Middle School from Year 5 to Year 8. Parents must apply for school transport by completing a **school transport application form** online by **30 June 2018**. Children will be issued with a bus pass when the application has been processed.

Please make sure that you have applied for a place on school transport for your child and that you do not miss the deadline of 30 June 2018. Late applications may not be processed in time for the start of the new term and you will have to pay for your child's journeys to and from school.
