## Treats for all children using fundraising money

#### Christmas post boxes

Christmas post boxes will be open in the hall corridor from Monday O5 December. Lists of children's first names and surname initials for your child's class have been sent home. Cards for children in your child's class should be taken to the classroom and the class teacher will arrange for them to be given out.

#### Christmas lunch on Wednesday 14 December

A Christmas lunch has been ordered for all children in Early Years class 2 and Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 to enjoy on Wednesday 14 December unless you have informed us in writing by the end of today.

Parents of children in Early Years class 2 and Years I and 2 do not have to pay for this meal as it is provided free due to the Universal Infant Free School Meals initiative. Parents of children in Years 3 and 4 who pay for their child's meals should pay in the normal way as part of the weekly payment on Monday I2 December. If you have told us that you do not want to order a Christmas lunch for your child please provide a packed lunch.

- Friday 09 December- Christmas fayre, including raffle, tombolas (soft toy, chocolate and general), pull a bottle, tattoos, colouring competition, hand-made crafts, hot drinks and biscuits, hot dogs, chips, juice and reindeer dust.
