Key stage 1 and 2 visit to Gosforth Synagogue

We are delighted to let you know that we have organised a school visit to Gosforth Synagogue for children in key stages 1 and 2. The children will be organised in to two groups and visit the synagogue on two different mornings. The visits will take place on the morning of **Tuesday 26 March** and on the morning of **Thursday 28 March**.

The purpose of this letter is to let you know about the visit in advance.

Purpose of the visit

The children have been learning about Judaism. The children will visit the synagogue to compare it to a Christian place of worship. They will learn about holy days and rituals followed by Jewish people. They will look at religious artefacts such as the Ark and the Torah scroll.

<u>Timings</u>
