Dear Parents and Carers

Summer term B after school clubs for children in Years 3 and 4

I am delighted to announce that we have organised an **after-school club** for boys and girls in **Years 3 and 4** for this half term. The club will take place on Thursday nights and will be provided by staff from the Newcastle United Foundation.

Newcastle United Foundation staff regularly work in our school providing both after-school clubs and teaching PE in PE lessons. They all have full DBS clearance and have undergone all of the checks required to work in school with children.

After-school club will take place **from 3:15pm – 4:15pm** in the hall or on the field. The club will focus on team games and will follow the direction given by the children to the coaches.

The club will start on **Thursday 09 June** and run for 6 weeks in total- Thursdays 09, 16, 23 and 30 June plus 07 and 14 July.

Please note that the club will only run for **4 weeks for Year 4 children**. This is because they will not be able to attend the club on Thursday 23 June as they are at Dukeshouse Wood and on Thursday 11 July as they on transition week.

Children must be collected at **4:15pm** from the main entrance at the school office, including Year 4 children who normally leave school without an adult at 3:15pm.

Children need to wear their **school PE kit** (plain white t-shirt, shorts/tracksuit pants and trainers). The children have PE lessons on Thursdays so should be wearing their PE kit for school. They will also need to bring a **drink**. The cost for your child to attend the club is £12.00 for Year 3 and £8.00 for Year 4. If you would like your child to take part, please complete and **return the reply slip to school and pay via School Gateway** by **Monday 13 June 2022.**
