Cake pledges will be sent out soon. We are very much looking forward to supporting the Macmillan charity again this year and to seeing parents and carers in school.

Punctuality reminder

We have made a super start to the new school year with all children arriving at school on time Please support us to make sure your child has the best possible start to the day by arriving at their classroom by 8:50am. Gates are locked at 8:50am and children who arrive after this time will not be allowed in.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Breakfast Club and an After School Club continue to operate in the Club Room.

Breakfast Club opens at **7:30am**. Please take your child to the Club Room. Staff from Breakfast Club will take your child to their classroom at the start of the school day. This costs **£3.50** per child and includes breakfast.

After School Club runs from **3:15pm to 5:30pm**. Staff from After School Club will collect your child from their classroom at **3:15pm**. Please collect your child from the Club Room. This costs **£7.00** per child and includes tea.

Bookings for Breakfast Club and After School Club must be booked and paid for in advance on School Gateway; children cannot turn up on the day without a booking.

We hope that this service will be well used and will support families in our village.

Reading books

Last academic year we bought a whole set of new **reading books** for school, paid for from our fundraising account. The reading books for children in Reception and key stage 1 are **closely matched to our phonics scheme**, so children will read books at home which will revisit and revise the sounds they have been taught in school. We have also bought a range of more **challenging and interesting texts** for our older children.

We will be giving out reading books next week. Do not be alarmed if you child brings home a reading book from a colour band that they have already read- we have reorganised the reading book bands. Teachers will explain about this at the class coffee mornings and at workshops that we have planned for this term.

Information for parents and carers

School Gateway

We are sending out a paper copy of today's newsletter along with the information for parents and carers. From now on, all newsletters will be sent out via **School Gateway**. School Gateway is the method for paying for clubs, school meals and milk and for giving consent. It is also used to send out text messages and emails.

We have been using this system for over a year now. If you have not downloaded the School Gateway app, please do so. We will try to help you to resolve any issues that you have, but cannot do so unless you have the app.
