School Relief fundraising days

We had a great week at the end of last term during our School Relief fundraising week. The children all did really well and completed their **sponsored run** on Friday 23 March. So far we have raised **£1600** from the Easter disco, celebration assembly, school relief coffee morning and sponsored run. Although we are very pleased with this amount, we have only received sponsor money from **39 children out of 109**. I assume that parents of children in all year groups will want their children to use an Ipad in school but we have only had money from around one third. **Please encourage children to collect all of their sponsor money and return it to school as soon as possible.**

PE kit

Parents are responsible for providing their child with a school PE kit. Children need their school PE kit (white t-shirt and dark shorts) and trainers for all PE lessons. PE lessons are likely to take place outdoors in the summer term depending on the weather. Children need their trainers for every lesson. School shoes cannot be worn for PE lessons.

Our expectations of a white shirt, dark shorts and trainers are very reasonable, especially compared to some schools where children must have a wide range of much more expensive items including things with school embroidered logos etc.

PE is a statutory part of the national curriculum and is not optional. Please support us to make a prompt start to PE lessons by ensuring your child has their top, shorts and trainers at school on PE days. Valuable time is wasted at the start of every PE lesson trying to sort out spare kit which reduces teaching time.

Summer term arrangements

It has been lovely to see the children back at school and some in their summer uniform. Please remember to send a named water bottle in to school so children can get drinks. Please apply sun cream before school and send in a hat for your child. Please also check that jumpers and cardigans are named. It is very difficult to match children to unnamed clothes.
