Letter 2 about the key stage 2 visit to Holy Island

Further to my letter of 10 January, I write to you again about our school visit to Holy Island for children in blue class on **Friday 28 February.** The purpose of this letter is to give you more details and to request written permission and the voluntary contribution.

Activities

The purpose of the visit is to complement the children's learning on the topic of The Vikings. We will be looking for evidence of early Christianity and Viking raids around Holy Island by visiting the Lindisfarne Priory and visitors' centre as well as the Heritage Centre (home of the Lindisfarne Gospels). We will walk around the harbour and spend some time on the beach.

<u>Timings</u>

The visit has to be planned around the safe crossing times to the island. In order to make the most of the day, we will be leaving school at **8:30am**. This means that children will have to be at school by **8:15am**.

We will be leaving Holy Island at 2:30pm, returning to school for 4:00pm (depending on the traffic).

<u>Cost</u>

The cost of the bus is **£298**. There is no charge for the children to go to the Lindisfarne Priory. There is a charge of £2.00 per child to visit the Heritage Centre. This makes a total cost of **£366**.

This is divided by the number of children in blue class and gives a price of **£10.76 per child**. We realise that this is a large sum of money. We have decided to subsidise the cost of this visit with **£200** from fundraising money so the cost to parents/carers will be **£4.00 per child**, therefore we are requesting a **voluntary contribution of £4.00 per child**. Lunches

All children will eat their lunch during a planned break between the activities. All children should bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to **free school meals** and you would like Mrs Rogage to prepare a packed lunch, please tick on the reply slip. A packed lunch will not be automatically provided unless you request one on the slip.

The children will be outside for the vast majority of their time on the island. They should wear warm and comfortable clothes and trainers. They do not need to wear school uniform.
