Thieves broke the padlock on the gate at the top of the drive at some time between 10pm on Monday and 7:00am on Tuesday, broke in to the van and drove it off the premises. Richard uses this van to transport the bikes to each school. It is a very important part of the service that Richard provides; he brings the bikes to ensure that all children have a high quality, checked and road worthy bike and helmet. The theft of his van has seriously compromised his ability to provide this service in the coming weeks while he sources a replacement vehicle. If you are aware of any information regarding the theft of Richard's van, please do report it to the police. They are aware of the theft and a crime number has been allocated, so I am sure that they would be grateful for the information.

Key stage 1 and 2 visit to the Gosforth Synagogue

Children in red, green and blue class had a very interesting visit to **Gosforth Synagogue** last week. Mrs Heyman and her very kind team of volunteers talked to the children about **Judaism** and **Jewish traditions**. The children saw important **Jewish artefacts**, including the **Torah scrolls**, the ark, candles and the **seder plate**.
