Dear Parents and Carers

Reminder about whole school visit to Northumberlandia on Monday 20 May

We have organised a visit to Northumberlandia for all children on **Monday 20 May** which will be the launch event for our **art topic week.** Following the visit to Northumberlandia, children will work individually and as a whole class on a number of art projects inspired by the landscape sculpture "Lady of the North". The week will culminate with the children's work being showcased in an art gallery. The art gallery will be open on **Friday 24 May from 2:15pm as part of our celebration assembly**. Parents and carers are encouraged to attend celebration assembly to look at their child's work in the gallery and find out about what the children have been learning during art week.

<u>Timings</u>

The visit will take place on the morning of Monday 20 May. We will leave school after registration at around 9:30am. Children should be at school by 8:45am as normal. We will be back at school by lunchtime. There are no changes to the arrangements at either the beginning or end of the day or at lunchtime. Children in orange class can be collected from the classroom at 11:45am as normal. Children cannot be taken home directly from the coach. It would help immensely if orange class parents would wait by the classroom door and not on Barrass Avenue where the bus stops.

<u>Cost</u>

We are paying for the cost of the coaches using fundraising money so there is no cost to parents/carers for this visit.

What do the children wear

Children should wear their school jumper and a warm and waterproof coat on their top half with joggers, leggings or trousers and trainers or sturdy shoes on the bottom half. Please don't wear school skirts, trousers or school shoes. Clothes need to be suitable for being outdoors and walking on paths and hills.

Your child's class teacher will let you know if we need your help on the visit.
