It is a huge undertaking to organise this event. The arrangements may sound a bit prescriptive but we need to ensure that we can fit in all of our special guests and serve them as well as the children, so please bear with us.

Father's Day lunches will be served in three sittings. Children will be able to eat their lunch with their special guest. We can only accommodate one special guest per family (not one per child).

If your child is in orange class and you would like to join us for Father's Day lunch, please provide a packed lunch for your child so they can eat their packed lunch next to you. School meals cannot be provided for children in orange class.

Tea and coffee will be on sale. You are invited to stay after your meal to enjoy a hot drink. **Raffle tickets** will also be on sale with three fabulous prizes on offer.

This year we will be giving you the option to order a **very special extra gift** for a special male adult when you order your Father's Day Lunch ticket. This gift will be personalised from your child (or children). Whole school visit to Northumberlandia on Monday 20 May

We are delighted to inform you that we have organised a visit to Northumberlandia for all children on **Monday 20 May**.

This will be the launch event for our **art topic week.** Following the visit to Northumberlandia, children will work individually and as a whole class on a number of art projects inspired by the landscape sculpture Lady of the North. The week will culminate with the children's work being showcased in an art gallery. The art gallery will be open on Friday 24 May from 2:15pm as part of our celebration assembly. Timings

The visit will take place on the morning of Monday 20 May. We will leave school after registration at around 9:30am. Children should be at school by 8:45am as normal. We will be back at school by lunchtime. There are no changes to the arrangements at either the beginning or end of the day or at lunchtime. Children in orange class can be collected from the classroom at 11:45am as normal. Children cannot be taken home directly from the coach.

Cost

We are paying for the cost of the coaches using fundraising money so there is no cost to parents/carers for this visit.

What do the children wear

Children should wear their school jumper and a warm and waterproof coat on their top half with joggers, leggings or trousers and trainers or sturdy shoes on the bottom half.
