<ul style="list-style-type: none">• use websites that an adult has chosen.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• tell someone else our password.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• tell an adult if we see anything we are uncomfortable with.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• arrange to meet anyone we don't know.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• close any webpage we are not sure about immediately.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• open e-mails sent by anyone we don't know.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• e-mail people an adult has approved.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• use internet chat rooms without adult supervision.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• send e-mails that are polite and friendly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• send pictures to anyone unless an adult has approved this.
