PE days for summer term B

Please remember that children cannot take part in PE lessons if they are wearing **earrings**. Please help us to meet the statutory requirements for PE by removing your child's earrings before school on PE days so they don't miss out.

Children in **Red, Green and Blue** class will be working with **Mr Dowson** from Shape Performance every Tuesday. Children in **Green and Blue** class will be working with coaches from **Newcastle United Foundation** every Thursday. Children in **Orange, Yellow and Red** class will have PE with their **class teacher** this half term.

Wearing face coverings on the school site

Thank you to parents and carers in most year groups who are continuing to comply with our request to **wear a face covering** while dropping off and collecting children.

We are aware that you are outdoors at the beginning and end of the school day and the road map is moving along. However, parents and carers wearing face coverings on the school site is still listed as a **key protective measure** in our risk assessment. We share a border with North Tyneside, where the levels of the Indian variant have been detected.

There is a noticeable difference between the number of parents and carers in red class who are wearing a face covering, especially at home time, and the rest of the classes. We know that you have a lot of space on the bottom yard, but please can we ask that you follow the request being made to all parents and carers in all year groups and wear a face covering, unless you are exempt from doing so.

We review our risk assessment weekly, including the wearing of face coverings. At the moment, we are still requesting that parents and carers in all year groups wear a face covering while dropping off and collecting children.



Covid reminders

If your child shows symptoms of Covid-19, please keep them and any siblings off school, arrange for them to take a test and self-isolate until you receive the results.

Parents must inform school of any test result, even if the test result is negative. Parents must inform school of any test result even if your child's year group is currently closed or if school is closed due to a weekend or a school holiday. If you are worried about the safeguarding of a child, please ring school on 0191 237 0419 or our **safeguarding number 07785 180484**. This mobile number can also be used to report a Covid test result if you do not have email access. Your call may go straight to answer machine, but messages are checked every day.

We ask that you continue to follow these principles-

- bring your child to school every day and be on time;
- follow our one way system, even if you think there is no-one checking;
- wear your face covering and maintain a distance from other parents and carers while on the school site.

Staff continue to take twice weekly lateral flow tests and all results have been negative.

Bags2school collection

We have organised our next **Bags2school** collection for **Tuesday 15 June.** A bag has been sent home to fill with any unwanted clothes. Bags are weighed and we are paid per kilo. The greater the weight we collect, the more money we receive for school. Any money we receive is used to pay for treats for our children.

If you need more than one bag, please see Mrs Elliott in the school office. Please drop off bags at the school office by **Friday 11 June** so the bags can be stored safely in quarantine before they are collected by Bags2school.
